Registration Fee and Payment

Registration fee:

50,000 Japanese yen for regular participant; 30,000 Japanese yen for student. The fees cover the scientific sessions, proceedings, welcome reception, banquet, and technical tour.

15,000 Japanese yen for accompanying person. This fee includes welcome reception, banquet, and technical tour but excludes scientific sessions and proceedings.

Accommodation

The organizing committee has blocked a limited number of rooms in several hotels/guest houses for attendees at a discounted rate. The rooms are available for only July 26th to 30th. Two types of accommodations will be available.

Type A: Hotel Epochal, Hotel Okura and Daiwa Roynet Hotel: about 9000 Japanese yen per night (incl. tax, without breakfast). Within walking distance to symposium site, bus stop, and train station.

Type B (Student priority/first come first basis): Ninomiya guest house: about 2000 Japanese yen per night (incl. tax, without breakfast), maximum 2 persons per room. Within walking distance from symposium site.

Participants are requested to mark their choice in the Preliminary Registration Form. Please note that this is not a hotel reservation request. Hotel Reservation Request Form will be asked later. Details of hotels will be announced in the second circular.
